Your message: Cycling home from Cambridge along Shelford Road this evening I was surprised to find that the contractors have erected large "no cycling" signs banning cyclists from using the very narrowed section of road at the roadworks for the Addenbrookes Access Road. It appears the intention is that cyclists should dismount and walk 100-200 yards.

I understand that it is not allowed to make this sort of ban unless a temporary TRO has been obtained, and I'm not aware of any such order for this stretch of road.

Please could you confirm whether cycling is to be banned here and show me the relevant order if so. Alternatively please could you ask the contractors to remove these unauthorised signs and allow cyclists to use this section of road.
