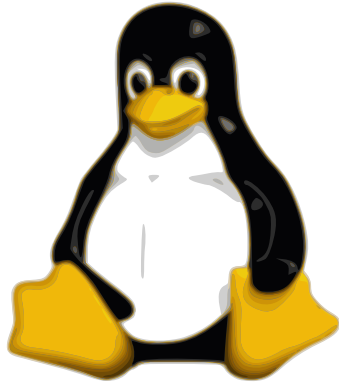

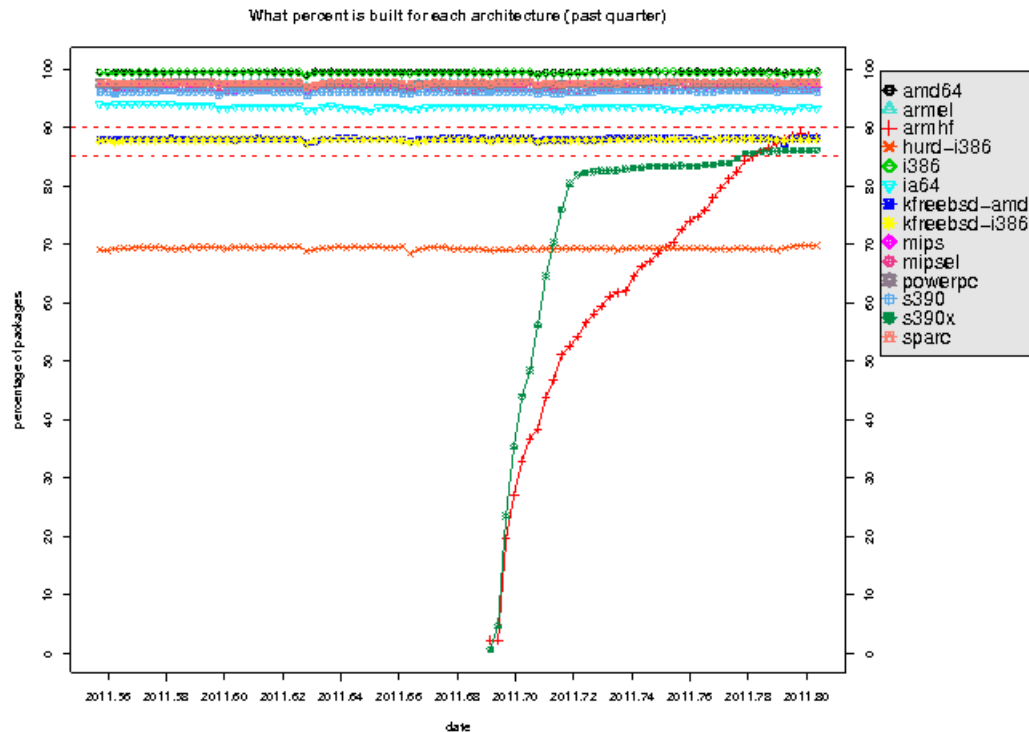
# Hard-float ABI

- Better performance
- Standardisation
- Servers

# Status in Debian

- 3 ports over time
  - “arm” (v3, OABI)
    - arm-linux-gnu
  - “armel” (v4t, EABI)
    - arm-linux-gnueabi
  - “armhf” (v7, EABI (hard-float), Thumb 2)
    - arm-linux-gnueabihf

# Debian armhf bringup



- ~95% done
- Fixing bugs
  - Ruby
  - Libreoffice
  - ...
- Language bootstraps
  - gcl
  - mono
- In testing now, ship with wheezy?

# Status in Ubuntu

- 2 ports:
  - “armel” (v7, EABI (soft-float), Thumb 2)
    - `arm-linux-gnueabi`
  - “armhf” (v7, EABI (hard-float), Thumb 2)
    - `arm-linux-gnueabihf`
